National

India opens two border crossing points with Myanmar, Bangladesh

i. India has opened two immigration check posts along the borders with **Myanmar and Bangladesh.** In a gazette notification, the Home Ministry stated the Central government has designated Zorinpui **land check post in Lawngtlai district** of Mizoram as an authorized immigration check post for entry into or exit from India with valid travel documents for all classes of passengers to or from **Myanmar**.

ii. The **Central government** has also designated Kawrpuichhuah land check post in Lunglei district of Mizoram as an authorized immigration check post for entry into or exit from India with valid travel documents for all classes of passengers to or **from Bangladesh**.

Madurai's Meenakshi Temple Named Best 'Swachh Iconic Place' in India

i. The Meenakshi Sundareswarar Temple has been adjudged best 'Swachh Iconic Place' in India.

ii. A total of 63 compact bins have been placed and four compactor trucks do the rounds around the temple premises. There are 25 e-



toilets and 15 water ATMs for tourists to use. There are two road sweepers and battery operated vehicles specifically purchased to clean this stretch.

India, Nepal to Conduct First Joint Tiger Count

i. For the first time, Nepal and India will undertake a joint tiger census in their national parks, forests and protected areas adjoining the two countries using a globally-recognised method. The counting of tigers will begin from the second week of November.



ii. Tiger is an endangered animal listed in the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES).

• The 13 tiger range countries include Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, Nepal, Russia, Thailand, and Vietnam.

Rajghat gets Mahatma Statue, for the first time i. Rajghat, the Samadhi of the Father of the Nation in the national capital , has for the first time acquired a new feature that could appeal to the large number of visitors. Vice-President of India Shri M.Venkaiah Naidu today unveiled a 1.80 metre tall bronze 3

statue of Mahatma Gandhi on the occasion of the 148 Birth Anniversary of the champion of country's independence. ii.The statue, sculpted by the renowned Shri Ram Sutar is installed in the Parking Area of Rajghat Samadhi Complex at a cost of Rs.8.73 lakhs. It is mounted on a two feet high pedestal clad with granite. The famous message of Gandhi ji "Be the Change You Wish to See" is inscribed on the front side of the pedestal. Installation of the Statue is a part of a large number of improvement works at Rajghat undertaken during the last three years.

Karnataka Launches mid-day Meals Scheme for Pregnant Women

i. The Karnataka government launched the

crore **Mathru Poorna scheme**, aimed at providing free mid-day meals to pregnant and lactating women in rural areas.



ii. The meals, which will be provided in Anganwadi centres, will include an

egg, rice, pulses, vegetables, and milk. This is aimed at reducing child malnutrition and in turn curb infant mortality.

Forbes India Rich List 2017: Mukesh Ambani Richest With \$38 Billion

i. Forbes Magazine has released its India Rich List for 2017, with Reliance Industries Limited chairman Mukesh Ambani topping the charts for the 10th consecutive year with a net worth of \$38 billion.

ii. Mr Ambani is followed by tech czar **Azim Premji** who jumped two places with the net worth of \$19 billion. Ranked third are the **Hinduja brothers** who added \$3.2 billion to their net worth. **iii.** According to Forbes, the combined net worth of the 100 richest Indians stood at \$479 billion, a jump of 26% from \$374 billion in 2016. Acharya Balkrishna, CEO of Patanjali Ayurved, figures at No. 19 with net worth of \$6.55 billion.

PM Modi Lays Foundation Stone for Bridge in Dwarka, Gujarat

i. Prime Minister Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of

a four-lane cable-stayed bridge between Okha and Beyt Dwarka. The bridge is a link between old and new Dwarka. The 2.32 km bridge, including 900 metres of central double span cable-stayed portion, will be constructed at a cost of Rs. 962.43 crore.



ii. The four-lane 27.20-metre wide bridge will have 2.50 metre wide footpaths on each side. Solar panels installed on the roof of footpath will produce 1 MW power for street lights on the bridge. **Important Takeaways from Above News-**

Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojana (PMKSY) has been started to provide a permanent solution from drought i. Government is investing Rs 50,000 crore for a period of five years to develop complete irrigation supply chain, water resources, distribution network and farm-level application solutions to achieve the target of providing water for every farm.

Bureau of Indian standards (BIS) Act 2016 brought into force with effect from 12th October, 2017

A new **Bureau of Indian standards (BIS) Act 2016** which was notified on 22nd March, 2016, has been brought into force with effect from 12th October, 2017. The Act establishes the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) as the National Standards Body of India. The Act has enabling provisions for the Government to bring under compulsory certification regime any goods or article of any scheduled industry, process, system or service which it considers necessary in the public interest or for the protection of human, animal or plant health, safety of the environment, or prevention of unfair trade practices, or national security. Enabling provisions have also been made for making hallmarking of the precious metal articles mandatory.

i. The Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat programme was launched by the Prime Minister on 31st October, 2016 to promote engagement amongst the people of State/ UTs in the country so as to enhance mutual understanding and bonding between people of diverse cultures, thereby securing stronger unity & integrity of India.

i. India Slips to 8th Rank in Valuable Nation Brand List

India switched places with Canada and its brand value dropped by one percentage point while that of Canada's rose 14 percent. 'Sex With Minor Wife is to be Considered Rape': Supreme Court

i. In a landmark verdict, the Supreme Court of India ruled that sex with a wife who is under 18 years of age is rape and therefore a crime. The top court did not rule on 'marital rape', which is sexual intercourse forced upon a spouse no matter what their age.

ii. Before SC ruling, there was an exception in Section 375 rape law provisions that protected a man who had sexual relations with his wife even if she was under 18, which is the age of consent. Exception 2 in Section 375 of IPC (Indian Penal Code) granting protection to husband is violation of the constitution and fundamental rights of minor bride, according to the Supreme Court.

ii. The 2017 GHI released by the

International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) termed India's hunger levels 'serious' problem at hand. The data from the report showed that India ranked lower than all its neighboring countries - Nepal (72), Myanmar (77), Bangladesh (88), Sri Lanka (84) and China (29) - except Pakistan, which has been placed at 106th in the global hunger list.

GDP May Grow at 7% in Financial Year 2017-18: NITI Aayog

i. According to NITI Aayog Vice-Chairman Rajiv Kumar, the economic slowdown that began in 2013-14 has bottomed out and the GDP is likely to grow at 6.9-7 % this fiscal (2017-18) and 7.5% in 2018-19. The economic growth slowed to 7.1% in 2016-17, the year in which 87% of the currency was demonstised, despite a very good show by the agricultural sector.

ii. On a quarterly basis also, the growth in the first quarter of the current fiscal had slipped to 5.7%. In the next fiscal year, the growth would be about 7.5%.

i. Petroleum Minister Dharmendra Pradhan has inaugurated the first phase of Piped Natural Gas supply system in Bhubaneswar, Odisha. In the first phase, 255 houses in Nalco Nagar in Chandrasekharpur of Bhubaneswar were supplied with environment-friendly PNG.

ii. As part of the City Gas Distribution project, around 25 thousand households in twin-city Bhubaneswar and Cuttack would get PNG connection by end of next year. The overall capital expenditure for the Bhubaneswar and Cuttack gas distribution projects will cost around Rs. 1700 crore.

i. The RBI has issued guidelines to banks will provide funds to women self-help groups, SHGs, in rural areas at 7 percent under the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NRLM) in the current fiscal (2017-18).

ii. The central bank has revised guidelines on interest subvention scheme under DAY-NRLM, as received from the Ministry of Rural Development for implementation by 21 public sector banks and 19 private banks.

ii. The state government has proposed a new airport in Rajkot district as the existing one is small and the earlier plan to extend the current runway could not materialise because of high land cost. The Environment Ministry has given the environment clearance to the Gujarat State Aviation Infrastructure Company Ltd (GSAICL) for development of a greenfield airport at Rajkot.

Most Pollution-linked Deaths Occur in India

i. With 2.51 million deaths in 2015, India has been ranked No. 1 in pollution-related deaths, according to a report by The Lancet

Commission on pollution and health. China recorded the second highest number of such deaths (1.8 million). India accounted for about 28 percent of an estimated nine million pollution linked deaths worldwide in 2015.



ii. The Lancet Commission on pollution and health is a two-year project in which more than 40 international health and

PM Modi Inaugurates the first phase of Ghogha-Dahej RORO ferry service in Gujarat

ii. Prime Minister Narendra Modi has inaugurated the first phase

of ambitious Ghogha-Dahej Rollon Roll-off ferry service at Ghogha in Bhavnagar district in Gujarat. **ii.** With the opening of this 615cores rupees ferry service, the distance between Saurashtra and South Gujarat regions could be



covered in less than an hour via-sea route. This passenger movement service reduced the distance between the Ghogha and Dahej from 310 kilometres by road to just 30 kilometres, which can be covered in one hour.

Honda overtakes Bajaj to seal No 2 spot in domestic bike sales i. Honda Motorcycle and Scooter India (HMSI) has raced past Bajaj Auto to become the second biggest bike seller in India during the first half of the ongoing fiscal. Market leader Hero MotoCorp continued its hold on the segment selling 33,44,292 units in the first half of the fiscal as against 30,34,504 units in the year-ago period, a growth of 10.2 percent.

ii. During the April-September period this fiscal, HMSI sold a total of 10,48,143 motorcycles in the domestic market registering a growth of 19.8 percent. On the other hand, Bajaj Auto sold 10,10,559 units witnessing a decline of 10.45 percent, according to the latest data from Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM). In the comparable period last fiscal, HMSI sold 8,74,852 units as against Bajaj Auto's 11,28,425 units.

India's First Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra Launched

i. The Union Home Minister Rajnath Singh along with Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Dharmendra Pradhan inaugurated India's first Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) for Skilling in Smart Cities, in collaboration with New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC).

ii. It is launched under skill India Mission. The ministers also laid the foundation for a Skill Development Centre at Moti Bagh and a Centre of Excellence at Dharam Marg, New Delhi.

Schedule for the General Election to the Legislative Assembly of Gujarat, 2017.

i. The term of the Legislative Assembly of Gujarat is normally due to expire on 22.01.2018. Gujarat Assembly election 2017 dates: 2-phase poll to be held on December 9, 14; counting on 18^{th} .

ii. By virtue of its powers, duties and functions under Article 324 read with Article 172(1) of the Constitution of India and Section 15 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Commission is required to hold general election to constitute the new Legislative Assembly in the State of Gujarat before expiry of its present term.

Himachal Pradesh election 2017 dates: Voting on November 9, counting on December 18

i. The Election Commission of India on Thursday said that elections to the 68-seat Himachal Pradesh Assembly will be held on November 9 and counting of votes will be done on December 18 this year.

Tamil Nadu Government Laid Foundation Stone for Rs. 198 cr Aerospace Park

i. The Tamil Nadu Chief Minister, Palaniswami, laid the foundation stone for an aerospace park at Kanchipuram district to be set up by the State Government in 245 acres and at an estimated cost of Rs 198 crore.



ii. When fully ready, the park will attract a total investment of nearly Rs 1,000 crore and create job opportunities for nearly 30,000, according to the State government.

Madhya Pradesh Tops in Digital Initiatives: Survey

i. Madhya Pradesh has emerged as the top state in terms of digital initiatives undertaken, with a maximum score of 100.1 on the performance index, followed by Maharashtra at 99.9 and Andhra Pradesh at 99.8, according to a report by Coeus Age Consulting.



ii. Chhattisgarh (97.4) and Karnataka (95.3) occupied the fourth and fifth positions in the list, respectively. The report is based on a comparative assessment of digital initiatives by 36 states and Union Territories.

PM Modi Inaugurates Global Conference on Consumer Protection

i. Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated a global conference on consumer protection in New Delhi. This is the **first time that an international conference on consumer protection is being organized by India** for countries of the region.

ii. Twenty-two countries from East, South and South-East Asia are participating in the international conference. These include China, South Korea, Singapore, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka.

Madras HC Bans Photos of Living Persons on Banners in Tamil Nadu

i. The Madras high court has banned the use of pictures of living persons on banners and hoardings in Tamil Nadu.

ii. Tamil Nadu's top officials were asked to maintain a clean environment and also ensure that there were **"no unnecessary drawings"** on buildings and residential places. The order states that pictures of the chief minister, ministers or politicians cannot be used in posters or hoardings. It has also banned the use of photos of people sponsoring the pictures.

3rd Global Investors' India Forum Held in New Delhi

i. Union Minister of State (IC) for Power and New & Renewable Energy, Shri R. K. Singh addressed the 3rd Global Investors' India Forum in New Delhi.

ii. The theme of the event was 'Ideate, Innovate, Implement and Invest in India' and it was attended by global industry stalwarts. In the forum, major focus was given on generation of



electricity and its distribution across the country. The event was organized by the ASSOCHAM.

ii. In the second quarter of 2017, India's smartphone market recovered quickly with shipments growing 23% year-on-year in the third quarter to reach just over 40 million units. Low smartphone penetration and the explosion of LTE (long-term evolution, or 4G) are the main drivers behind this.

i. Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL) became the first Indian company to cross **Rs 6 trillion market capitalization** after its shares surged over 75% so far this year and hit a fresh lifetime high.

cabinet to a senior post in the kingdom's equivalent of a sports ministry. Daughter of a former Saudi Prince, Princess Rima is a graduate from an American university. Saudi Arabia does not allow women to practise sports in the public sphere and even the introduction of private sports centres for women has aroused criticism among religious conservatives in the Gulf state.

Pak withdraws Hafiz Saeed's detention request under antiterrorism law

i. Pakistan government today withdrew its request for extending

the detention of Mumbai attack mastermind and JuD chief Hafiz Saeed under the anti-terrorism law. On January 31, Saeed and his four aides were detained by the Punjab government for 90 days under preventative detention under the Anti-



Terrorism Act 1997. They have been under house arrest since then.

ii. Explaining as to why the government withdrew its application, a senior official of the Punjab government told a news agency that since all five of them are detained under the public order there was no binding on the government to produce them before the review board to seek extension to their detention. The JuD has already been declared as a foreign terrorist organisation by the United States in June 2014.

i. China marked the 68th National Day on 01st October

2017 with more than 115,000 people from across the country gathering at the **Tian'anmen Square** to watch the raising of the National Flag in Beijing. ii. The seventh-grade student was inspired by the large-scale lead contamination in water in Flint, Michigan, that came to light recently. Rao won \$25,000 for taking the top position at the 2017 Discovery Education 3M Young Scientist Challenge.

Singapore Passport Named 'Most Powerful', India Ranks 75

i. Singapore's passport has become the most powerful in the world with a Visa-Free Score of 159, according to the Passport Index developed by advisory firm Arton Capital. This is the first time an Asian country has been announced as having the most powerful passport.



ii. India secured the 75th rank in the index with a Visa-Free Score of 51. Historically, the top 10 most powerful passports in the world were mostly European, with Germany having the lead

for the past two years. Afghanistan was on bottom most position (94th) with the score of 22. Pakistan was on 93rd Position with Iraq with the score of 26.

water being its only emission, the tram emits no pollutants. No nitrogen oxides will be produced as the temperature of the reaction inside hydrogen fuel cells is controlled under 100 degrees Celsius.

US court largely blocks Trump's military transgender ban

i. A US court has largely blocked President Donald Trump's controversial ban on transgender people serving in the military. Mr Trump had, in August, signed an executive order banning transgender



people from serving openly, reversing former President Barack Obama's directive allowing them to do so. The move prompted a flood of lawsuits, many of them filed on behalf of transgender service members or veterans. US District Judge Colleen Kollar-Kotelly sided in part with a group of transgender service members who sued to block

Uhuru Kenyatta wins controversial Kenyan poll rerun

i. Kenyan President Uhuru Kenyatta has been declared the winner of a controversial re-run of the Presidential election. The country's Election Commission said, he won 98 per cent of the votes with a turnout at just under 39 per cent - less than half that was recorded in August's vote. ii. It was Federer's first success against the Argentine in a Basel final, after the South American beat him in both 2012 and 2013. Federer moved ahead of Ivan Lendl into standalone second place on the Open Era titles list, only trailing Jimmy Connors, who owns 109 trophies.
