National

India gets first US LNG shipment at Dabhol, Maharashtra

i. India received its first LNG cargo from the US under a long-term supply deal when a ship carrying super-cooled natural gas arrived at Dabhol in Maharashtra.



ii. GAIL India has contracted 3.5 million tonnes per annum of liquefied natural gas (LNG) from US energy firm Cheniere Energy's Sabine Pass liquefaction facility in Louisiana. The first cargo from the project arrived at Dabhol, the cite of India's biggest gas-fired power plant.

Madhya Pradesh's Kadaknath chicken gets Geographical Indication tag

i. Six years after it applied for the Geographical Indications (GI) tag for Kadaknath, a chicken breed whose black meat is in demand in some quarters, Madhya Pradesh has got the coveted label.

ii. Chennai-based GI Registry accepted the application of Gramin Vikas Trust, Jhabua, which was filed in 2012.

India Becomes 2nd Largest Producer of Mobile Phones in the World

i. India is now the second-largest mobile phone producer in the world after China. According to the data shared by Indian Cellular Association with the government, annual production of mobile phones in India increased from 3 million units in 2014 to 11 million units in 2017.

ii. With this, **India replaced Vietnam** to become the second largest producer of mobile phones in 2017.

Delhi Becomes 1st City to Roll-Out Euro VI Fuel

i. With an aim to combat the rising levels of air

pollution in Delhi-NCR region, petrol pumps in the capital started supplying ultra-clean Bharat Stage VI grade fuel (both petrol and diesel).



ii. This move makes New Delhi the first city in the country to switch from BS-IV grade fuels to BS-VI (equivalent to fuel meeting Euro-VI emission norms).

Bloomberg Billionaires Top 100 Index Released

i. Reliance Industries Chairman and Managing Director Mukesh Ambani has been ranked 19th on Bloomberg Billionaires Top 100 Index as he becomes the third richest Asian on the list. With a net worth of approximately \$38.3 billion, Ambani's wealth is pegged at about over 1.5 percent of India's GDP.

ii. While Amazon CEO Jeff Bezos has added \$21.8 billion to his fortunes this year and takes the top spot, Microsoft founder Bill Gates was ranked 2nd. iii. From Asia, Alibaba co-founder Jack Ma (ranked 13th) is the richest with a net worth of \$47.2 billion and is followed by Tencent co-founder and CEO Pony Ma (17) with a \$41.1 billion net worth.



- ii. In 2017, 5.09% of global threats detected were in India. The U.S. (26.61%) was most vulnerable to such attacks, followed by China (10.95%), according to 'Internet Security Threat Report'.

Patna Tops in 4G Connectivity Among 20 Largest Cities: Report

i. Patna tops in 4G connectivity among 20 of India's largest cities. It has emerged ahead of the likes of Bengaluru, Mumbai and Delhi, according to the



report of OpenSignal, a wireless coverage mapping company.

ii. Four cities from India's central and eastern regions—Patna, Kanpur, Allahabad, Kolkata, Bhopal and Lucknow—made it to the top 10 while popular tech hubs like Bengaluru are at 10, followed by Hyderabad, Mumbai and Delhi.

Cabinet Approves Protection of Human Rights (Amendments) Bill, 2018

i. The Union Cabinet has given its approval to the Protection of Human Rights (Amendments) Bill, 2018 for better protection and promotion of human rights in the country.

- It proposes to include "National Commission for Protection of Child Rights" as deemed Member of the Commission:
- It proposes to add a woman Member in the composition of the Commission;
- It proposes to enlarge the scope of eligibility and scope of selection of Chairperson, National Human Rights Commission as well as the State Human Rights Commission; and
- It proposes to incorporate a mechanism to look after the cases of human rights violation in the Union Territories.

- The Indian Research Space Organisation launched the Indian Regional Navigation Satellite System-11, the eighth such satellite to be a part of a constellation. It was launched from the first launch pad at the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh.

ii. India's 17-year-old shooter Mehuli Ghosh set a Commonwealth Games joint record to win silver in the women's 10m Air Rifle event. Ghosh and eventual gold medallist Singapore's Martina Lindsay Veloso both ended with record score following which the winner was decided by a shoot-off. India's 25-year-old shooter Apurvi Chandela won a bronze medal in the same event.

India Win Badminton Team Gold for 1st Time in CWG History

i. India clinched their first-ever badminton mixed team event gold in Commonwealth Games history after defeating defending champions Malaysia 3-1 in the final at Gold Coast.

ii. India's previous best performance in mixed team event at CWG was a silver-medal finish in the 2010

edition. Saina Nehwal and Kidambi Srikanth represented India in singles' matches of the five-member team event.

Indian Men's TT Team Wins Gold

i. India defeated Nigeria to clinch gold in the men's table tennis team event at the Commonwealth Games for the first time since 2006.

ii. With this, India joined England to bag second-most table tennis gold medals (5) at CWG. This is the first time that India have won both men's and women's TT team events at a single CWG edition.

Weightlifter Punam Yadav Wins 5th Gold For India

i. India's weightlifter Punam Yadav won gold in the Women's 69kg weightlifting category. Yadav lifted a combined total of 222kg (100 snatch and 122 clean and jerk) and defeated England's Sarah Davies her closest competitor to take her second medal at the Commonwealth Games.

ii. This was India's fifth gold medal in the ongoing games. Venkat Rahul Ragala earned India the fourth Gold medal after lifting 338 kilograms in the Men's 85 kg category.

Indian Women's TT Team Wins Gold

i. India has bagged three more Gold, one Silver and

two bronze medals at the 21st Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast on the fourth day. Indian women's Table Tennis team won their first ever



Gold Medal defeating Singapore.

ii. Manika Batra led Table tennis team's victory was historic as Singapore had never lost since 2002.

Heena Sidhu Wins Gold in 25m Pistol Event

i. Indian shooter Heena Sidhu set Commonwealth Games record to win gold in women's 25m pistol shooting event. This is Sidhu's second medal at



CWG 2018, after winning silver in women's 10m air pistol.



ii. Another Indian shooter Annu Singh came sixth in the same event. With this result, India has won three golds and overall eight medals in shooting.

CWG 2018: Manu Bhaker Claims 10m Pistol Gold i. India's 16-year-old Manu Bhaker won the gold in women's 10 air pistol while Heena Sidhu staged a remarkable recovery to secure silver at the 21st Commonwealth Games in Gold Coast.

ii. Bhaker shot 240.9 to break the Commonwealth Games record, finishing well ahead of her senior teammate Sidhu, who aggregated 234. The bronze medal went to Australia's Elena Galiabovitch who ended with 214.9.

Leander Paes becomes most successful player in Davis Cup

ii. Forced to play together by AITA, 44-year-old Paes and Bopanna downed a fighting Chinese pair of Mo Xin Gong and Ze Zhang in the do-or-die doubles rubber of the Asia/Oceania Group-I tie.

Shooter Shreyasi Singh Wins 12th Gold

- i. Indian shooter Shreyasi Singh won the women's double trap gold in a shoot-off after scoring 96 points to take India's gold medal tally at the 21st Commonwealth Games 2018 to 12.
- **ii.** This was her second CWG medal after having claimed a silver at the 2014 Glasgow Games. Another Indian shooter Varsha Varman finished fourth in the event, scoring 86 points.

India's Kidambi Srikanth Becomes World No. 1 Badminton Player

- i. Kidambi Srikanth has become the first Indian male badminton player to attain the world number one ranking since Prakash Padukone in the 1980s.
- ii. Srikanth had become the first-ever Indian to win four Superseries titles in a year in 2017. It helped India

win gold at the mixed team event at the Commonwealth Games for the first time ever.

Sushil Kumar Wins Gold in Wrestling

i. Indian wrestler and Olympic medallist Sushil Kumar bagged his third straight Commonwealth Games gold medal after winning the men's Freestyle 74 kg event.

ii. The 34-year-old wrestler won the final 10-0, having dominated all previous opponents with scorelines of 11-0, 10-0, and 4-0. Sushil has a silver and a bronze in Olympics and was crowned world champion in 2010.

Rahul Aware Wins India's 1st Wrestling Gold

- i. Rahul Aware bagged India's first wrestling gold medal at the Commonwealth Games 2018 after beating Canada's Steven Takahashi in the final of men's Freestyle 57 kg event.
- ii. Before the final, the 26-year-old had claimed two dominating victories with the scorelines 11-0 and 10-0, while he defeated Pakistan's Muhammad Bilal 12-8 in the semi-final.

CWG 2018: Tejaswini Sawant Wins India's 5th Shooting Gold

i. Tejaswini Sawant won India its fifth shooting gold medal at the 2018

Commonwealth

Games, winning the women's 50m Rifle 3 Positions Finals in Gold

Coast, Australia.

ii. This was 37-year-old Tejaswini's second medal at the 2018 edition, after winning silver at the women's 50m Rifle Prone. India's Anjum Moudgil won silver at the event, after having topped qualification.

CWG 2018: Anish Bhanwala Becomes India's Youngest CWG Gold Medalist

i. Fifteen-year-old shooter Anish Bhanwala became India's youngest gold medalist at the Commonwealth Games,

Commonwealth Games, winning the men's 25m



Rapid Fire Pistol Finals with a record score at Gold Coast, Australia.

ii. India's Neeraj Kumar stood fifth at the event. Anish, who is participating in his first Commonwealth



Games, won gold at the ISSF Junior World Cup in Sydney 2017.

Naman Tanwar Wins India's 1st Boxing Medal

i. Nineteen-year-old Naman Tanwar won India its first boxing medal at the 2018 Commonwealth

Games, winning a bronze in the men's 91 kg category.



ii. Naman lost out to Australia's Jason Whateley in the semifinal of the event to secure the bronze. India has won a total of 35 medals, including 16 golds, 8 silver and 11 bronze medals so far.

Bajrang Punia Wins His 1st CWG Gold

i. Wrestler Bajrang Punia won his first Commonwealth Games gold medal, defeating Wales' Kane Charig by technical superiority in the men's freestyle 65 kg final in Gold Coast, Australia.
ii. This is India's fifth medal in wrestling in this edition, with Rahul Aware and Sushil Kumar registering gold wins earlier. Bajrang had won a silver medal at the 2014 Commonwealth Games.

Sanjeev Rajput Clinches Gold in Shooting

- i. Shooter Sanjeev Rajput won the men's 50m Rifle
- **3 Positions** with a Games record at the 2018 Commonwealth Games to seven.
- ii. The gold was Rajput's third successive medal at the CWG, after having bagged silver and bronze in the 2014 and 2010 editions respectively. India's Chain Singh stood fifth in the same event.

Neeraj Chopra, 1st Indian to Win Gold in Javelin Throw

i. Neeraj Chopra became the first Indian javelin thrower to claim a gold medal at the Commonwealth



Games, with a season's best effort of 86.47m in the final.

ii. The 20-year-old junior world champion had made the final after achieving the qualifying mark in his very first throw. Neeraj was favourite for gold after his 85.94m throw in March 2018 at Patiala during the Federation Cup National Championships.

Mary Kom, 1st Indian Woman to Win CWG Boxing Gold

i. Five-time world champion and Olympic bronze medallist MC Mary Kom has become the first Indian woman boxer to win a gold medal at the Commonwealth Games.

ii. Mary Kom achieved the feat after defeating Northern Ireland's Kristina O'Hara in the 45-48kg category final at Gold Coast, Australia. The 35-year-old boxer from Manipur is participating in her maiden Commonwealth Games.

Kidambi Srikanth Wins his 1st CWG Silver

i. World number one Indian shuttler Kidambi Srikanth won his career's first Commonwealth Games singles Silver medal.

ii. In the final, the 25-year-old Indian lost to Malaysia's Lee Chong Wei, who won his career's third Commonwealth Games singles gold medal. Notably, only three Indian shuttlers have won CWG men's singles title—Prakash Padukone (1978), Syed Modi (1982) and Parupalli Kashyap (2014).

Saina Nehwal Wins Historic 2nd CWG Gold

i. Shuttler Saina Nehwal defeated world number

three PV Sindhu in the firstever all-Indian women's singles final at the Commonwealth Games.



ii. With this, Nehwal claimed

her second Commonwealth Games singles gold medal after having won it at the 2010 Delhi Games. **Nehwal is the only Indian female badminton player to win singles gold** in Commonwealth Games history.

Daniel Ricciardo Wins Chinese Grand Prix 2018 i. The 2018 Chinese Grand Prix was a Formula One

i. The 2018 Chinese Grand Prix was a Formula One

motor race that took place at the Shanghai International Circuit in Shanghai, China. Red Bull's Daniel



Ricciardo won the race ahead

of Valtteri Bottas and Kimi Raikkonen.

ii. The race was the third round of the 2018 FIA Formula One World Championship and marked the fifteenth time that the Chinese Grand Prix has been run as a round of the Formula One World Championship.

i. India finished third in the medals tally at the Commonwealth Games



2018 with 66 medals (26 Gold, 20 Silver and 20 Bronze).

ii. Only Australia with 198 medals and England with 136 were ahead. India's 26 Golds was also third, behind Australia (80) and England (45). India's combined 66 medals is its third-best showing in the history of the Games.

iii. India's best remains 101 in New Delhi (2010), followed by 69 in Manchester (2002).
