National

Hallmarking to be mandatory for gold jewellery and artefacts

i.Hallmarking of gold jewellery and artefacts will be made mandatory across the country from January 15, 2021. The step aims to ensure the purity of the precious metal. The decision will make it compulsory for all the jewellers to register with the Bureau of Indian Standards and sell only hallmarked gold jewellery and artefacts.

ii.A notification in this regard will be issued on January 15 2020 and the decision will come into effect after a year.

iii.Gold hallmarking is a **purity certification** of the precious metal. It is voluntary in nature at present. The BIS is already running a hallmarking scheme for gold jewellery since April 2000.

iv. The Bureau of Indian Standards has formulated standards for hallmarking gold jewellery in 3 grades: 14 carat, 18 carat and 22 carat.

India becomes 1st country to make entire Haj process digital

i.India has become the 1st country to make the entire process for pilgrims going on Haj completely digital. ii.An online



application, e-visa, Haj mobile app, 'e-MASIHA' health facility, "e-luggage pre-tagging" providing all information in India itself regarding accommodation and transportation in Mecca and Madina will be provided to 2 lakh Indian Muslims going for Haj in 2020.

iii. Minority Affairs Minister Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi signed the bilateral annual Haj 2020 agreement between India and Saudi Arabia with Haj and Umrah Minister of Saudi Arabia.

India's first maritime museum coming up at Lothal in Gujarat i.Government of India (GoI) & Portugal has decided to cooperate in

the setting up of an India's **1st National Maritime Heritage Museum** at the ancient Indian site of **Lothal** in **Gujarat** with the aim to boost the underwater or marine archaeology.

ii.The

Museum will showcase salvaged material from shipwreck sites in the Indian Ocean waters.

FIA invites Anand Kumar for India's Republic Day celebrations in New York

i.The Federation of Indian Association (FIA) has invited Super

30 founder Anand Kumar to a function on the eve of India's Republic Day celebrations in New York. ii. The Federation of Indian



Association is the oldest organisation of the non-resident Indians. Year "2020" also marks the 50th anniversary of FIA. Anand Kumar has been invited for his contribution in the field of education through his programme 'Super 30'.

iii. 'Super 30' is a programme that prepares 30 students from underprivileged sections of society for the prestigious IIT entrance test every year, without any fees.

Israeli student's made satellite "Duchifat-3" to be

launched from Sriharikota
i.The "Duchifat-3", Israeli
student's made satellite will be
launched from ISRO's
Sriharikota launch site.
ii."Duchifat-3" is a satellite jointly
built by Herzliya Science
Center and Sha'ar HaNegev
High School students of Israel.



iii.It is a remote sensing satellite through which students from all schools across the country will be able to experiment and carry through Earth observation. "Duchifat-3" is the 3rd in the series of Israeli student-made satellites.

•Duchifat-3 weigheing 2.3 kg is a photo satellite to be used for ecological research of Earth from space.



Ripu Daman Bevli as "Plogging Ambassador of India" on 50th Fit India Plogging Run

i.Ripu Daman Bevli was appointed as Plogging Ambassador of India by Kiren Rijiju, Minister of State for Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) on the 50th



Fit India Plogging Run held in Delhi's Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium.

ii. The minister also launched the Plogging
Ambassador Mission to nominate Indians who have been running and cleaning their cities, towns or districts as Plogging Ambassadors of their region.

iii. Plog run is a unique way of picking up garbage while jogging, it was added to the Fit India Movement as an initiative to combine fitness with cleanliness like combining the Fit India Movement and Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.

1st time India's forex reserves cross \$450 billion i. The country's foreign exchange reserves crossed the \$450-billion mark for the first time ever on the back of strong inflows which enabled the central bank to buy dollars from the market, thus checking any sharp appreciation of the rupee.

ii.India's foreign exchange reserves were at \$451.7 billion on December 3, 2019, an increase of \$38.8 billion over end-March 2019.

iii. The Reserve Bank has always maintained that it intervenes in the foreign exchange market to curb volatility and does not target a particular level of the exchange rate.

i.Tennis legend Roger
Federer will become the first living person in
Switzerland to have a coin minted in his honour.



ii. The Federal Mint, Swissmint, has created a **20-franc** silver coin bearing Federer's image.

iii.It's the first time in its history that Swissmint has created a commemorative coin to honour a living person.

Aberdeen in A&N Islands declare best police station in country

Police i.Aberdeen station in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands ranks 1st in the list of the best-performing police stations in the country while dealing with a property offence, a crime against women and weaker sections. Ministry Home

released the list of ten best-performing Police stations in the country.

ii.Balasinor police station in Gujarat secured the 2nd rank while and Ajk Burhanpur in Madhya Pradesh got the 3rd position.

iii. The ranking of police stations came after Prime Minister Narendra Modi while addressing the DGPs conference in 2015 in Kutch of Gujarat, had directed that parameters should be laid down for grading police stations and assessing their performance based on feedback.

iv. The ranking of top ten Police Stations out of over 15 thousand 500 Police Stations in the country was done through data analysis, direct observation and public feedback.

ISRO begins preparations for setting up 3rd rocket launchpad

i.Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) has begun

preparatory works for setting up a **3rd rocket launchpad** in the small coastal hamlet



of Kulashekhrapattinam in the Thuthukudi district of Tamil Nadu.

ii.At present, the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) has two launch pads at Sriharikota in Andhra Pradesh.

iii. The demand for additional launch pads has arisen as a result of the increase in the number of satellite launches from India, both for domestic and international customers.

FASTags becomes mandatory for all vehicles from 15th December 2019

i.FASTags or prepaid rechargeable tags for toll collection have become mandatory for all vehicles from 15th December 2019.



ii. The FASTags or prepaid rechargeable tags allows automatic payment of toll. The government launched the National Electronic Toll Collection

System which provides for the collection of user fee through FASTag to save fuel and time, curb pollution and ensure seamless movement of traffic.

iii. National Highways Authority of India has equipped all fee plazas with Electronic Toll Collection System. iv. With the help of a FASTag, drivers will not have to stop their vehicles at toll plazas to pay tax.

v.A FASTag uses radio frequency identification technology to enable direct toll payments from a moving vehicle.

India among top 10 countries with higher climate performance

i.India, for the first time, ranks among the top 10 in this year's Climate



Change

Performance Index

(CCPI) at the COP25 climate summit in the Spanish capital Madrid.

ii. The current levels of per capita emissions and energy use in India ranked 9th in the high category showing that emissions are still comparatively low.

iii. The authors of the report noted that while the country receives an overall medium rating in the renewable energy category, India's 2030 renewable energy target is rated very high for its well-below 2 degrees Celsius compatibility.

iv. They noted that as none of the countries assessed is already on a path compatible with the Paris climate targets, the first three places of the ranking remain unoccupied.

v.While some EU countries such as Sweden (4th) and Denmark (5th), one of the best climbers, achieve overall high or very high ratings, the performance of EU countries varies largely.

the UK vi.While only two G20 countries,

(7th) and India (9th), are ranked in the high category, eight G20 countries are remaining in the worst category of the index.


vii.Australia (56th out of 61), Saudi Arabia and above all the US perform particularly poor.

viii. The index is jointly presented by Germanwatch, NewClimate Institute and Climate Action Network.

India ranks 129th in Human Development Index 2019

i.India has been ranked **129th** among 189 countries in the Human Development

Index 2019 released by



Development Programme (UNDP).

ii. India was ranked 130th last year in the index. Norway, Switzerland, Ireland occupied the top three positions in the index.

iii. According to the report, South Asia was the fastest growing region in human development progress showing a 46% growth over 1990-2018, followed by East Asia and the Pacific at 43%.

Facts related to India:

- •India's HDI value increased from 0.431 to **0.647**, which places it above the average for countries in the medium human development group (0.634) and above the average for other South Asian countries (0.642).
- •In the Inequality-adjusted HDI (IHDI), India was ranked 130th, losing nearly half the progress (0.647 to 0.477) made in the past 30 years.
- •The IHDI indicates percentage loss in HDI due to inequalities. In the Gender Inequality Index (GII), India is at 122 out of 162 countries.
- •The Human Development Index measures average achievement of the countries in 3 basic dimensions of human development expectancy, education and per i.e. life capita income.



ISRO to launch earth observation satellite, RISAT-2BR1

i.The ISRO(Indian Space Research Organisation) will launch its earth observation satellite, RISAT-2BR1 on PSLV-C48 from the



First Launch Pad (FLP) of Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota.

ii.RISAT-2BR1, a Radar imaging earth observation satellite weighing about 628 kg, will be placed into an orbit of 576 km at an inclination of 37 degrees.

iii.PSLV-C48, which is the 50th mission of PSLV, will also carry 9 customer satellites of Israel, Italy, Japan and USA as co-passengers.

iv. These international customer satellites are being launched under a commercial arrangement with NewSpace India Limited.

Edelweiss AMC launches India's 1st corporate bond 'Bharat Bond ETF'

i.Edelweiss Asset Management Company (AMC), a subsidiary of Edelweiss Capital Limited (ECL) has launched India's 1st Corporate Bond ETF (exchange trade fund) called the Bharat Bond ETF.

ii.The ETF is a government initiative and Edelweiss AMC was given the mandate to design and manage the product.

iii. Edelweiss aims to raise an initial amount of Rs 3,000 crore through this bond from institutional players with a greenshoe option of Rs 2,000 crore in the 3-year maturity period (2023) and Rs 4,000 crore with a greenshoe option of Rs 6,000 crore in the 10-year maturity bucket (2030).

iv.Small retail investors will have to invest at least Rs 1,000 in this fund.

v.After this, there is a facility for multiple investments. Here they can invest up to 2 lakhs.

vi. At the same time, the minimum amount for anchor investors has been fixed at Rs 10 crore.

iii.Iceland has topped the report and remains the world's most gender-neutral country while Yemen was ranked the worst (153rd) in the report.

iv. As per report, the most improved countries were Albania, Ethiopia, Mali, Mexico and Spain. Among regions, Western Europe has made the most progress on gender parity



(standing at 76.7%).

v.As per WEF, the time it will take to close the gender gap has narrowed to 99.5 years in 2019 while the number was 108 years in 2018.

vi.WEF stated that this year's improvement can largely be ascribed to a significant increase in the number of women in politics.

ii.In Dec 2000, the UN General Assembly


proclaimed 18 Dec as International Migrants Day after considering the large and increasing number of migrants in the world.


